“All we have left is a chimney.” When her clients called with this news, what had started as a simple home renovation project for Jody Myers-Fierz had quickly turned into much more. And with a second baby on the way, the couple also needed the house built and furnished in just nine months.

Faced with a larger project and a tight deadline, Myers-Fierz worked closely with the clients to fulfill their vision of a home that doubles as a peaceful retreat from everyday life. To create the serene getaway the couple craved, the master bedroom was especially designed to be a haven of tranquility. “They wanted this room to be their sanctuary, a place where they could relax and de-stress,” she says.

Building on the wife’s love of gray and ivory tones, Myers-Fierz layered in textured elements for dimension, warm metals for depth and soft fabrics for comfort. She strategically selected pieces that incorporated touches of gold, patterns and a mix of metals for points of interest. The result is an ethereal, intimate space where the weight of the world melts away.
